### WELCOME & FUN - 10 MINUTES

#### WELCOME | Welcome your C3Kids

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** *Take some time to welcome the kids. Be full of energy and have fun with it. Remember, it's been a long time since we've all been together. So celebrate this time as C3kids returns to in-person gathering.*
- **SAY SOMETHING LIKE:** Hello everyone! Welcome back to C3Kids! We have missed you and are so excited to be back and to see all of you again!
- As we get started, you'll notice that things are a little different. Let me go over a few things with you.
  - o As you can see, we are all sitting around tables. We're going to ask that you stay at your table while we are here.
  - o You are also wearing a mask. We're going to ask that you keep your mask on while we're together.
  - o If you need anything, need to use the bathroom, or have a question, please raise your hand and we will acknowledge you.
  - o Does anyone have any questions?
- **SAY SOMETHING LIKE:** Now, who's ready to have some fun?

#### ACTIVITY | Holy Spirit Wind

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** *Give the kids their own pile of craft sticks and Play-doh and ask them to attempt to build a church building. Challenge them to try and build their church without it falling down.*
- **SAY SOMETHING LIKE:** Today, we are going to talk about how the Holy Spirit came like a blowing wind on Pentecost and gave people the power to start the church!

#### ACTIVITY | Did you know?

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** *With the poster board hanging up front, ask the kids to come up with a list of as many countries around the world as they can think of by going down the alphabet. They probably won't come up with very many, but that's okay. After five minutes, say something like this...*
- Did you know there are 195 countries in the world? That's a lot of different cultures, languages, and traditions! And God cares about every single person in every single one of these countries!
- In today's Bible story, we're going to find out what Jesus wanted the disciples – and us – to do in the world.

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** Worship is a big part of our time with C3Kids. We will have the song videos loaded and ready for singing. Take some time this week to watch the songs and become familiar with them. Invite kids to sing and dance along to fun worship songs to celebrate Jesus.

- **SAY SOMETHING LIKE:** Today we are going to talk about how everyone can come to know God. God's waiting for us with open arms so let's run!

## THIS WEEKS MAIN LESSON - 20 MINUTES

### OBJECT LESSON | Who is the Holy Spirit? - Part Four

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** *There will be a wrapped a model kit with an attached gift tag with C3Kids on it.*
- **SAY SOMETHING LIKE:** The Holy Spirit is a special gift from God. God gives us this gift to show us love and kindness . . . and because we really need it! Why do we need the Holy Spirit?
- First of all, how do you feel when you get a gift? What if you got a gift on a day that you were feeling down? It would have helped you feel better to know that someone cares about you, right?
  - The Holy Spirit is always with us and comforts us when we need it.
- It's important to know where a gift comes from and who it's for. We usually find this information on a card or a gift tag (*Show everyone the gift tag that has your name on it*).
  - Much like a gift tag tells us who the gift belongs to, the Holy Spirit lets us know that we belong to God.
- And when we get a nicely-wrapped gift, what do some of us like to do before opening it? We like to shake it and try to guess what's inside. We might make our best guess, but we won't know until we actually unwrap the box (*Remove the wrapping paper*).
  - Whenever we don't know what God wants us to do, the Holy Spirit tells us!
- What do we have here? It's a model kit. I don't know how to make this model! What do I do? Ah, yes, I need to find the instruction manual (*Pull out the instruction manual for the kit*).
  - The Holy Spirit helps us understand God's instructions to us and guides us through each step.
- In order to put this kit together, I need all the pieces. And here they are, inside this box (*Dump out contents onto table*)!



- The Holy Spirit provides us with all the tools we need to draw closer to God – our own "gifts" and abilities to do God's work.
- Let's see what kinds of things people were able to do because of the Holy Spirit!

### SCRIPTURE | Acts 2:1-21

- **ASK THIS QUESTION:** *Can you imagine being suddenly able to speak other languages?*
- **SAY SOMETHING LIKE:** Imagine meeting a friend from another country who doesn't speak the language you speak. **How could you communicate with them if you don't speak their language?**
- **SAY SOMETHING LIKE:** Let's travel back in time to see what happened on a special day called Pentecost.
- **INSTRUCTION:** *Use the time travel device from last week. Point your arrow to the plate with the corresponding Scripture and play this sound effect. When you are ready, play this week's video.*

### VIDEO | Legacy, Episode 4

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** *Point the arrow on your "device" to the plate with the corresponding Scripture and play this week's video. The video will include a bible video and a visit from our friend Carll from GrowTV.*

### DISCUSSION

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** *After the video, take a few minutes to ask these questions.*
- **Ask the following questions...**
  - *Where were the disciples when the Holy Spirit appeared?*
  - *What happened when the people were filled with the Holy Spirit?*
  - *What did people think about the disciples when they heard them speaking their own languages?*
  - **Re-read Psalm 139:7-10.**
  - *Where is the Holy Spirit?*
  - *If you could learn to speak another language, what would it be?*
  - *How does knowing that the Holy Spirit is for everyone affect how you treat others?*
  - *What is one way the Holy Spirit can change you?*

### POLL | World Traveler

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** *Show [this video](#) of the most iconic landmarks around the world. Write down all the places from the video on a board. Ask the kids which of these places they would most want to go and tally the responses.*
  - **PRETEEN HACK:** *Ask questions like the following: Would you rather travel somewhere cold or hot? / Would you rather visit the mountains or water? / Would you rather travel for spicy food or sweets? / Would you rather travel in a small group or with a lot of people? Have kids write down each of*



*their choices. Then provide travel books, brochures, or devices connected to the internet and have them search for a place to visit that would fit most of those criteria.*

- Aren't each of these places around the world so cool? What makes the world even more special than all of these landmarks is the people!
- Each one of us is different. We look different, we speak different languages, and we have a variety of cultures. But even though we are so different, there is one thing we have in common: God loves us. And God has provided a way for all of us to love God back. **The Holy Spirit is for everyone!**

### **THE BIG IDEA** | The Holy Spirit is for everyone.

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** *Open the legacy pod with this week's Big Idea words inside and call up one kid at a time to pull out one sheet of paper at a time. Help the kids arrange the words in the correct order. Read the Big Idea out loud together.*
- **The Holy Spirit is for everyone.**

### **MEMORY VERSE** | Time Travel Verse

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** *Practice saying the verse together a few times as a group. Then ask for five volunteers who are confident about the verse. Line them up and have them say the entire verse backwards, with each person saying one word at a time. Feel free to try this a few more times with different sets of volunteers.*

### **PRAYER**

- Dear God, we are so grateful your love includes all of us. Thank you for giving us the Holy Spirit, so we're never truly alone. Help us to be the ones who remind the world that the Holy Spirit is for everyone. Amen.

## **TABLE ACTIVITY - 5 MINUTES**

### **ACTIVITY** | Decoder Gadget

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** *Give each kid a Decoder printable, scissors, and a brad. Have them cut out the two circles, overlap them at the middle, and bind them together by poking the brad through the middle. Have kids rotate the circles and line up the letters in any position they want. The bigger circle is for the letters in the original text, and the smaller circle will be the code letters.*
- Write today's Big Idea: **The Holy Spirit is for everyone.** Then under it, write the message in code, using your new decoder. Once you line up the letters, keep it in that position for the whole code!
